Originally compiled and edited by Louis Kí_hler, this edition contains some of the most popular keyboard sonatinas, rondos and other works (including symphonic transcriptions) of Beethoven, Clementi, Haydn, Kuhlau and Mozart, among others. In clarifying this edition, editor Allan Small has removed impractical fingerings and unnecessary accidentals found in other editions.

This unique collection includes proven favorites such as 'Clowns' and 'Toccatina' along with works previously difficult to find, such as the 'Rondo from the Opera Colas Breugnon' and 'Lyric Tunes.' The preface by Kabalevsky's daughter, Maria Kabalevskaya, and the previously unpublished photographs of Kabalevsky and his family will add to the performer's understanding of these immortal teaching pieces.

Selected from the two volumes of Bartóks For Children, these 42 works were written without octaves to fit the hands of younger players. Each piece has a descriptive title, with half including the words "song" or "dance". Like much of the composer's writing, the pieces directly reflect the use of folk idioms.
